- 1. Welcome and introductions by Angelia Campas, Chair of the Esperanza Elementary School Community Council. The meeting was called to order at 9:32AM.   - A. The principal informed the council that the Utah State Office of Education (USBE) had a approved an expansion to Esperanza of 50 new students for 2024. Additionally, USBE also approved the addition of 7<sup>th</sup> grade. As a result Esperanza will be transitioning to an intermediate school with hopes of adding 8<sup>th</sup> grade in 2025-2026.
  - B. Currently we have 539 students enrolled
  - C. 110 in the waiting list.
- 5. Calendaring- We start testing today- Día de los Muertos is coming up, and we have several activities planned to celebrate the school's 10the anniversary. Pin, a shirt, and a banquet among several activities during the year. Parents also suggested to have the parade outside so that all kids get to see each other. Parents could also remain outside.
