MINUTES

1. Welcome and introductions by Angelia (Kavoni) Campas, Chair of the Esperanza Elementary School Community Council for last year. The meeting was called to order at 9:32AM. Mr. Alejandro informed the council that Jessica Ramirez was invited to participate in the council because nobody volunteered to “run” to be in the council. Maestra Ariana Cortes, a kindergarten teacher asked parents. The council unanimously approved Jessica Ramirez to be on the Esperanza School Community Council. We gave Jessica Ramirez time to introduce herself. A native of Chihuahua, Mexico she wants to learn what it takes to be part of the council and more about voting and such. 4. Mr. Alejandro informed the council that all students had taken the Beginning Of the Year test (BOY). All students were tested except for one student who was absent. Mr. Homar Gosain will be present at the next meeting to go over the results.
5. The council held a conversation about the video that introduces the council to the Land Trust Program. It was mentioned that the money the council receives comes from the State Landtrust, according to the video. All of the money is kept in place only the interest is given out to schools. Mr. Alejandro asked council members who who have not seen the video to do so.
6. Mr. Alejandro presented the Principal’s Report:
 - A. The 7th grade group only includes 30 students
 - B. Currently we have 575 students enrolled
 - C. 122 in the waiting list.
