MINUTES

1. Alfreda Hurlich welcomed the members. Alfreda took the roll. A quorum was present.
2. Approved the minutes of the December meeting.
3. Mr. Alejandre shared the final results of the RISE tests from 2020-2021. In English, 20% of our students were proficient, this will be used as the baseline for future goal setting. In math, our 22% of our students were proficient, this will also be the baseline for future goal setting. The results represent a 3% learning loss in English language arts, and 11% learning in math. In science our students were 27% proficient, which represents a 4% increase.
4. Principal's Report
 - A. Student enrollment is a bit down, with 527 students enrolled. According to charter directors at the last state directors' meeting, this trend is noticeable around the state. We are still above our maximum, but lower than in past years.
 - B. Parents on the council are content with pick up and drop off system. Some parents are arriving super early, but there is not much that a school can do.
 - C. Kindergarten enrollment is under way and we have nearly all the students (81) that we can enroll right now. Nine students will be enrolled in June. The rest will be placed on a waiting list.
