

Continuing Enrollment Policy

Students who do not attend at least two hours of interactive learning with a certified teacher and do not complete at least 70% of the classwork assigned –for ten consecutive days- will be dropped from the rolls.

Esperanza Elementary School will begin school on August 24th and expects students to attend in person. Parents have the option to petition the school for permission to attend school online or create a hybrid schedule (some days in person and some days online). Students who attend in person will begin school at 8:15AM to 1:15PM, Monday-Thursday. Additionally, students will be expected to complete at least 70% of classwork assigned after 1:15PM Monday-Thursday or on Friday. Teachers will be expected to provide online support until 3:45PM Monday-Friday as needed. One teacher per grade level will work extended hours to provide support online for parents and students until 5:00PM Monday-Thursday. Teachers will be online while instructing in person students. A paraprofessional in each classroom will manage communication between the teacher and online students using an online platform. Esperanza Elementary School will closely monitor contagious activity and adjust schedule accordingly.
