**Goals**

**English Language Arts: improve SAGE score from 18% to 20% (10% increase)**

**Final SAGE score: 26% Exceeded the goal (47% increase)**

**5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> grade mathematics goal: SAGE Score from 26% to 28%**

**Did not meet SAGE score: 25.3% virtually the same as 2017-2018**

**Plan to improve:**

- 1. Hired a team of interventionists to work with teachers to focus on literacy and the teachers will have more time to focus on math instruction.**
- 2. The state replaced Questar with AIR, providers of the testing system. As a school, we improved by 8%, but sixth grade faced tremendous challenges in completing the testing, due to the system crashing.**
- 3. Identify areas of need and provide tutoring in small groups or individually.**
